## a) Personnel Manual Update

President Sewell reported to the Commission and staff about some changes to the first draft of the Port Personnel Manual. Further changes will be discussed at the May 10<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting.

# b) Port Credit Card Update

Office Manager Mary Barnett reported that the new U.S. Bank Port credit cardholder agreements were signed and cards distributed.

## c) Executive Director's Report

### i. Broadband

 Joe Poiré from Petrichor Broadband discussed with Commission and staff the details of a possible contract between the Port and Petrichor for broadband planning services. President Sewell advised that a motion would not be passed to approve the contract until further information was available.

## ii. Wallace Way Business Park West Update

- <u>SEPA Update</u> The SEPA application was presented to the City of Grandview, and final comments are due by April 28<sup>th</sup>.
- <u>Real Estate Signs</u> The new real estate signs for Grandview and Wallace Way West Business Parks are ready to be picked up. A local contractor will be hired to install the signs.
- <u>Pole Removal Update</u> All poles have been removed from Lots #1 and #2.
- <u>SVID Drain Relocation</u> The Bureau of Reclamation will sign the Agreement and will return it so that the Port can record it.
- <u>Business & Industrial Infrastructure Update</u> Port Engineer Travis Marden, presented a new cost estimate for WWBPW Business & Industrial Infrastructure, roadway stub, cul-de-sac and infrastructure improvements. Travis updated Commissioner and staff about engineering to be done on WWBPW and advised that Pacific Power would do the power design.

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- <u>Pump Removal</u> Davis Pump removed the filter housing, power meter and pump at WWBPW to give the Port a value of its worth.
- President Sewell advised the Commission and staff about possible price increases that have occurred since the SIED grant/loan for WWBPW infrastructure improvements was approved.
