- <u>Construction Update</u> Port Engineer Travis Marden advised Commissioners and staff that WWBPW Infrastructure Construction Project bids will be opened on Friday, July 15th at the J-U-B office in Kennewick. Executive Director Randy Tucker will attend.
- <u>Handhold Purchase</u> Randy Tucker reported that the Port of Clarkston has 7 handholds for broadband service available for purchase. Randy advised that ordering the handholds from a supplier will take up to 48 months.

• <u>Second request from Leroy Ridenour to Extend Time for Removing Anchors from Balance of Property, Due to Heat.</u>

Commissioner Lyall moved and Commissioner Shenyer seconded a motion to advise Mr. Ridenour that due to the construction schedule, it is not possible to extend the entire contract; however, the remaining pole and anchor removal will be cancelled, and the remaining pole and wire portion extended to Dec. 31, 2022, and the pole and anchor portion be awarded to another contractor who can perform the work immediately. The Executive Director advised that he would hire Oscar's Tractor Custom Service to remove the remaining anchors for an estimated \$420 plus tax. Motion carried.

- <u>WWBPW Property Mowing</u> Randy Tucker reported that the Port billed property owners Barajas and Heitzman for the mowing of Lots 1 and 2 at Wallace Way BP West.
- <u>Boundaries of Properties for Marketing Purposes</u> Commissioners and Executive Director discussed adjusting boundaries of Wallace Way Business Park.
