1. CALL TO ORDER

The Special Meeting was called to order by President Jim Sewell at 5:31 p.m. on Tuesday, July 19th, 2022 at 1313 W. Wine Country Rd., Suite #101, Grandview, Washington and via Zoom. 2. WALLACE WAY BP WEST INFRASTRUCTURE CONSTRUCTION BIDS

Commissioner Lyall moved and Commissioner Shenyer seconded a motion to approve an Interagency Agreement with the Port of Clarkston for the purchase of handholes in the amount of \$5,095.44 for the Wallace Way BP West Infrastructure Project and to authorize the Port President to sign the Agreement. Motion carried.
